

These specific rules for Carp fishing are in addition to the general lake rules that must also be read and followed;

- Book online only
- 2 rod limit
- Oak pool has areas of weed, please fish accordingly.
- Fishing must take place only from the platforms provided.
- Landing net, unhooking mat & weigh slings are all provided by the fishery, please do not bring your own on to site.
- Minimum line strength is 12lb
- No fish to be sacked at any time, all fish to be returned to the water immediately after capture and photographing
- Spodding and baiting up is permissible when it will not unduly affect the fishing of other anglers.
- Markers must be removed at the end of your fishing, feature finding or baiting up session.
- Carp Care kits are compulsory NO EXCEPTIONS.
- When photographing fish, support the fish over the large unhooking mat provided, kneel and never stand up with the fish
- Best practice fish handling is expected from all anglers to ensure that while you get great photos of your hard earned captures, the fish's welfare is always paramount. High quality, large unhooking mats are provided and must always be used. Fish must be transported in a landing net or sling from the water to the unhooking mat and returned to the water in the sling. Fish must never be carried in your hands to or from the water. Keep fish wet at all times during photography sessions. Use a recognised, branded wound antibiotic agent on hook holes and any other external wounds, lesions or sores. Have wetted weigh slings, zero adjusted scales, forceps, water bucket, cameras, wound dressing agent, etc. ready to use in your swim before lifting a fish from the water. When returning fish to the water you must use the zipped sling. Do not transport the fish in any other way
